

Thomas Clarkson Academy 16-19 Tuition Fund statement

Background

The 16 to 19 tuition fund was a £96 million one-off fund for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. For example, vocational courses where assessment has been deferred because of lockdown. After the ongoing disruption to learning, to ensure no child is left behind and to help ensure those from economically disadvantaged backgrounds are supported in their studies, the fund has been given another £102 million for 2021-2022.
