

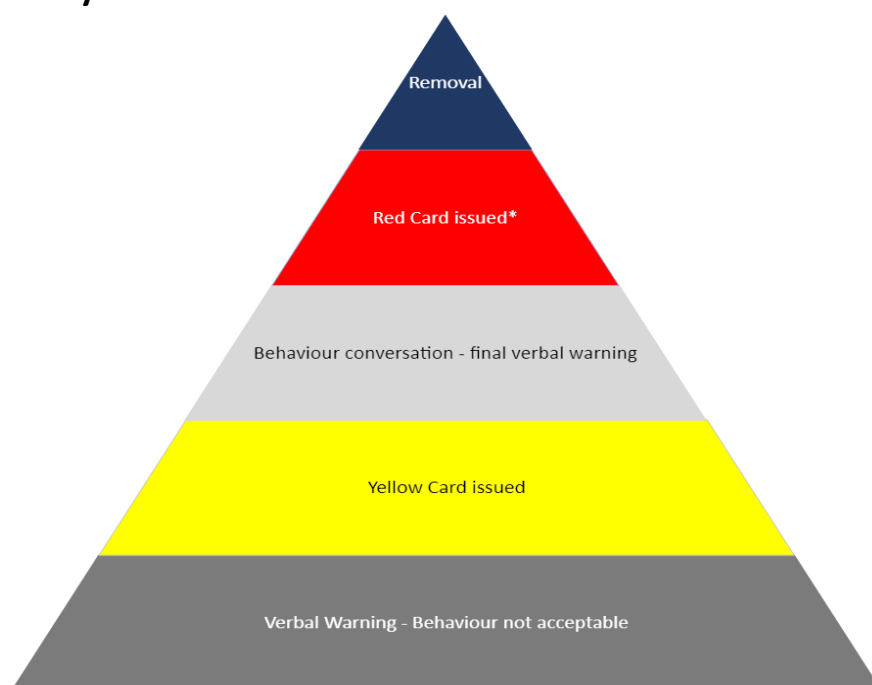
TCA 'One Page' Behaviour Policy

"Teachers can teach without disruption, students can learn without distraction"

Expectations for Students:

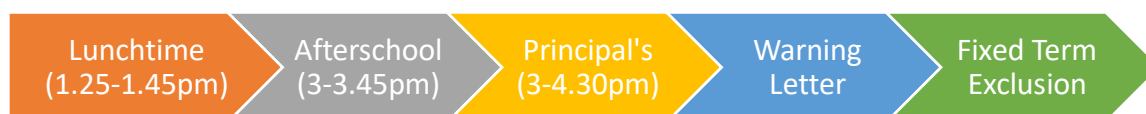
- **Punctuality:** Students must arrive on time for school and all classes.
- **Uniform:** Adherence to the school uniform policy is mandatory.
- **Conduct:** Respect, Safety and consideration for others are always expected.
- **Learning:** Pupils are expected to access the learning offered in every lesson and not prevent the teacher from educating the pupils within their classroom/learning area/outside space.

Behaviour Pathway:



Removal from lessons results in students being placed into a buddy room. Staff reserve the right to escalate straight to a red card with behaviours they deem to be serious breaches of TCA's expectations.

Detention Pathway



The RESET Room (9:00am-3.45pm)

- Time in RESET is identified following behaviours that have “breached” TCA’s expectations.
- Students can be placed into RESET for single lesson, half or full days.
- Being in RESET means a removal from mainstream school to work in an alternative environment.
- Failing to meet RESET expectations could result in ISR or Fixed Term Exclusion.

What constitutes being moved into RESET?

- Receiving 3 red cards in a single school day (persistent disruption to learning).
- A serious misbehaviour (outlined below).
- A student being involved in an ongoing investigation.

ISR: Internal Suspension room (10:00am-4.30pm)

- Situated next to the Executive Principal’s office.
- A student within this room will work 1:1 with a senior member of staff for the duration of the day.
- A parental meeting will be held during the day to discuss the circumstances which led to ISR.
- Failing to attend ISR/school means absence is unauthorised and affects your attendance data.

Failing to meet expectations within the ISR

- Failing to meet expectations within the ISR will result in a Suspension/Fixed Term Exclusion (FTE).
- FTE is a removal from the Academy for a set period of time.
- FTE is logged onto the student’s personal file.

Serious Misbehaviour

- Serious breaches of acceptable behaviour, such as identified bullying, persistent truancy, possession of banned items, violence or abuse towards students/staff, will be addressed with escalated consequences that could result in multiple days of FTE, Manage Move or possible Permanent Exclusion.

Truancy

- Students must follow their given timetable daily without exception.
- Concerns with a student’s timetable must be communicated in advance so we can support in dealing with any issues impacting learning and progress.
- Any student not attending the full lesson by walking out and not following removal/buddy process will be sanctioned with a straight afterschool detention the next day. Neither is permitted.

Our Community

- We work alongside our Safer School Partnership Police officer to support acceptable/appropriate community behaviour of all students at TCA.
- Students are ambassadors of TCA at all times and this includes on the way to/from school and trips.
- Behaviour outside of school reflecting poorly on the school community may be sanctioned.
